### REFLECTION

We return to Ordinary Time and to Mark once again. This particular 'season' of the Church's Year takes us through the ordinary ministry of Jesus – his teaching, his healing, his 'everyday' encounters with others. This can, if we let it, be a simple and clear reminder to us that mission is something we do in the ordinary and in the everyday; at home, at school, at university, in the workplace, in those places we encounter friend and stranger. Mission need not be something spectacular and extra-ordinary. It can be the way we go about life each day living and proclaiming the Good News of Jesus simply by who we are! But Jesus in today's Gospel allows us to see the hallmark of the disciple: someone who does the will of God. As we leave Easter, and the beautiful Solemnities that follow, behind now and return to the ordinary and everyday, may our ordinary and everyday be opportunities to let Christ into that ordinariness in order that we might just know he is near to us in the simple things of every day. May we allow others to encounter Christ in us in ordinary ways.
